Doray finds possible second lode

WEST Australian gold explorer Doray Minerals says recent drilling results from its Andy Well project, 45km north of Meekatharra, indicate potential for a second high-grade lode, south of the existing Wilber Lode deposit.

Aircore drilling at Andy Well aims to test the various target zones for mineralisation additional to the Wilber Lode, with a maiden JORC resource expected by the end of February. Doray managing director

Allan Kelly said the Wilber Zone was only one of at least seven highly prospective, northeast-trending zones of mineralisation within the Andy Well prospect.

“The results we are starting to receive from the current aircore drilling programme confirm our belief that we have only just scratched the surface of the potential endowment of Andy Well,” he said. “In particular, the mineralisation observed within the new zone

south of Wilber appears to be of similar grade and style to the original Wilber Lode discovery, however, further drilling will be undertaken to confirm this.”

Doray will continue to test a number of the other parallel target zones, along with extensions to the Wilber Lode during the current quarter, with the ultimate aim of defining a global resource at Andy Well that justifies on-site treatment infrastructure.
