

Doray Commences Maiden Drilling Programme

Doray Minerals Limited (ASX: DRM, "Doray") is pleased to announce the commencement of its maiden drilling programme at the Company's Meekatharra North gold project, located 45km north of Meekatharra in Western Australia (WA).

Doray listed on the Australian Securities Exchange early last month after raising \$4.6 million to explore and develop its strategic land package in the Murchison region of WA and the Central Gawler Gold Province of South Australia.

The aim of Doray's initial 2,000m RC drilling programme at the Meekatharra North gold project (Meeka North) is to confirm the grade and continuity of high-grade gold mineralisation at the Andy Well prospect, immediately adjacent to the Great Northern Highway.

Doray's Managing Director, Mr Allan Kelly, said he was excited to finally have the opportunity to test these prospective targets.

"Andy Well contains a number of historic high-grade drill intersections discovered by previous explorers in the mid-late 1990's, but the prospect has seen no systematic gold exploration since this time," said Mr Kelly.

"When WMC sold the projects in 1997, they had recognised indications of something potentially very significant at Andy Well, but no work has been completed since then," he said.

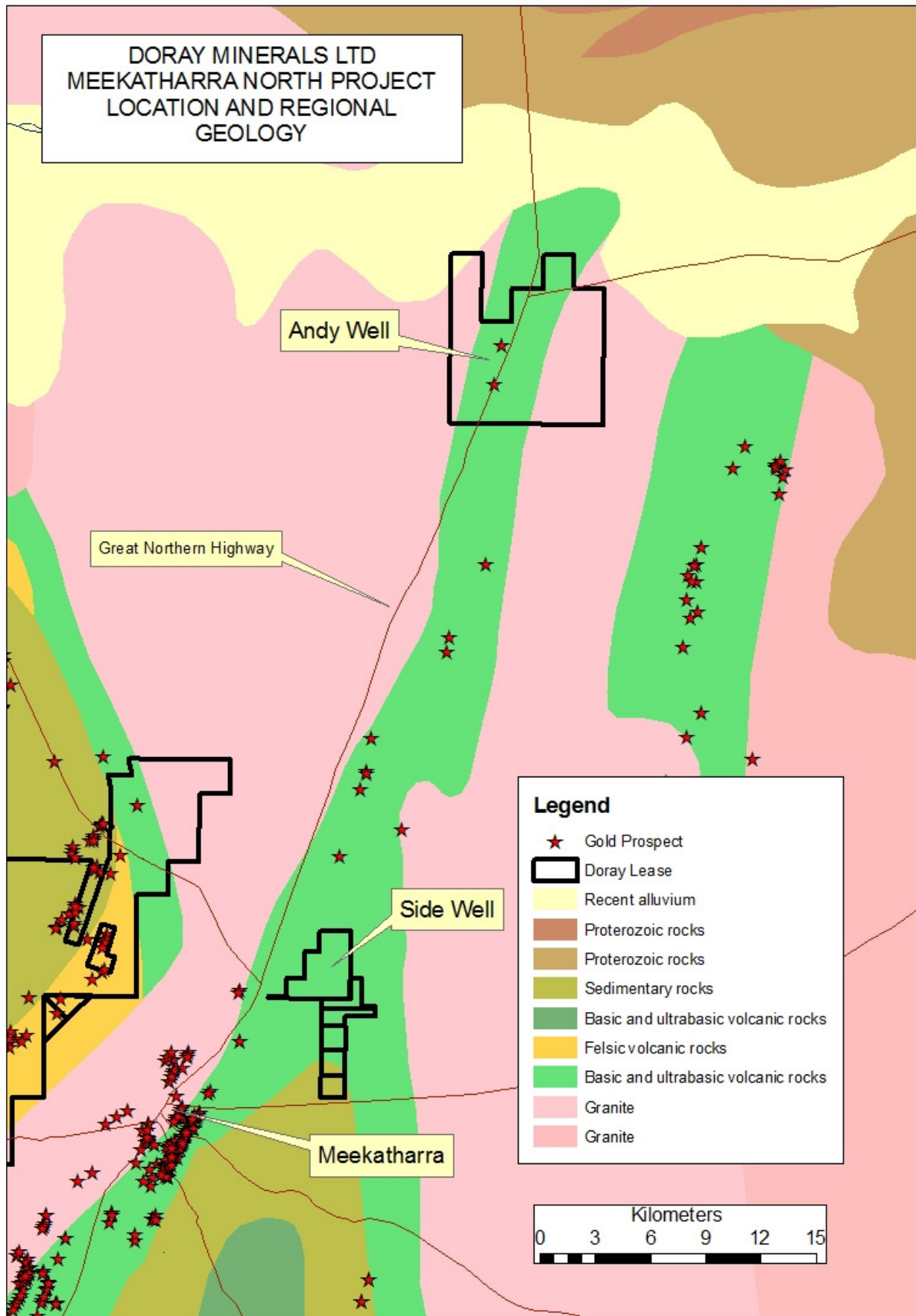
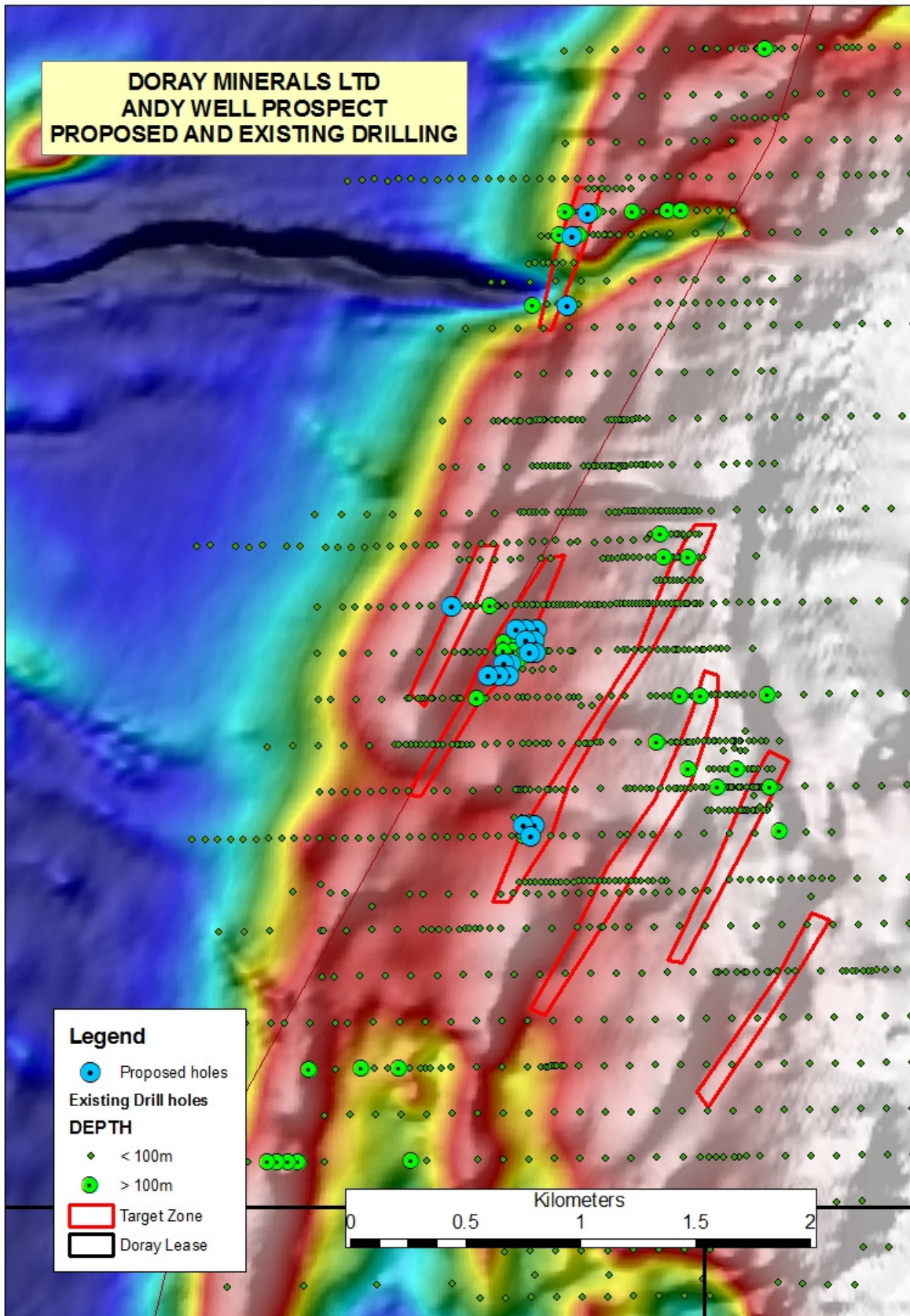


Figure 2. Magnetic image of the Andy Well prospect area, showing previous and proposed drilling in relation to NE-trending mineralised structures.

Previous explorers identified a series of parallel, northeast-trending structures, clearly visible in detailed aeromagnetic data (Figure 2). These structures host the mineralisation, but the vast majority of drilling was less than 100m deep and therefore potentially remains open at depth and along strike.

Doray's first drill programme will focus on the Wilber prospect, east of Great Northern Highway, where the best results were obtained.

Doray expects this initial drilling programme to take two to three weeks to complete with results expected early next quarter.

Figure 1. Location of Meeka North and Andy Well, showing gold occurrences and regional geology.
