# Doray drills deeper

DIAMOND drilling at Doray Minerals' Andy Well prospect near Meekatharra has extended the depth extent of the Wilber Lode by more than 50m, a 50 per cent increase. The vertical extension of the Wilber Lode significantly increases the potential for an economic underground resource.

The Andy Well prospect, located within the Meekatharra North Project of which Doray holds 80 per cent. Doray managing director Allan Kelly said the results substantially increased the potential tonnage of the Wilber Lode.

"These intersections are highly significant and provide us with added confi-

dence that the Wilber Lode could potentially be a significant high-grade underground resource," Mr Kelly said.

"That's in addition to the shallow, potentially open-pittable mineralisation defined so far."

Meanwhile, Doray is in the final stages of obtaining approvals for a substantial drilling campaign at Andy Well and Webbs Patch expected to begin by the end of this quarter.

Exploration licences at Abbotts and Mingah have also recently been granted and the company is in the process of finalising initial exploration programmes for these projects.
